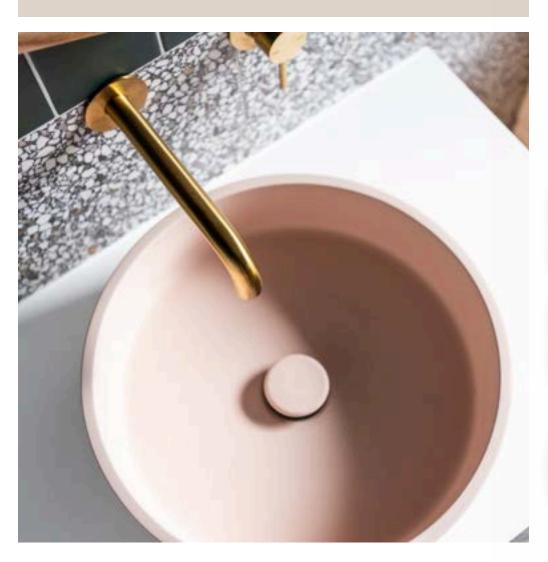

PROJECT STAGES

Building or renovating your home is an exciting journey, but it can also be complex and challenging. To help you navigate each phase with confidence, we've outlined the key stages of your project.

From initial concept to the final touches, this guide provides a straightforward breakdown of the process, so you'll know exactly what's happening and when.

PROJECT STAGES

(01)

PLANNING

This step includes laying out your budget, working with your/our designer and us to communicate your vision, securing permits for the build, and any other pre-planning steps. It's essential to establish a clear financial plan to ensure that your remodel stays on track and within your means.

02

DEMOLITION

You can't build in the new without tearing out the old!

Demolition can run a full range of intensity, from simply moving out old furniture and tearing down a few walls to a full tear down

03

BUILD & FRAME

This phase is where your home's new structure begins to take shape, giving form to the layout changes you've envisioned.

Whether it's building your home, adding new rooms, expanding existing spaces, the framing process is crucial in defining the physical boundaries and bringing your design to life.

04

INFASTRUCTURE

This step includes all the "behind the scenes" elements and typically runs concurrently with rebuilding and framing.

Basically, anything that needs to go inside floors, walls, or ceilings will be completed in this step. It could include some minor adjustments to plumbing and electrical or could be a full rewiring or replumbing of your home.

FIT OUT

Drywall can go up, primer, paint, or other finishes. At this stage, your space starts to feel more like a home again as the rooms take on their final shape. Whether it's laying down hardwood, tile, or stone, This step is crucial in pulling the entire look of your home together. Anything that needs to be "fixed" into your space will be installed at this time. Kitchen and bathroom cabinets, along with other built-in fixtures that will start to go in, giving your rooms their functional structure.

FINAL TOUCHES

This is the stage where all the hard work starts to pay off. Backsplashes are installed, that perfect faucet you picked for the half bath goes in, wallpaper is put up, and accessories, art and furniture are moved in. As the final touches are added, the whole home remodel transforms your house into a home.

SUMMARIES & BILLING

Summaries will be provided in conjunction with this Fee Proposal. The summaries detail the full scope of work. The project is organized into six (6) stages, and fees are invoiced upon substantial completion of each stage. Certain tasks are ongoing/iterative and may span multiple stages; the continuation of such tasks into later stages will not delay a stage being deemed substantially complete for invoicing purposes, provided the other stage-specific deliverables are substantially completed (as reasonably determined by J & M Construction Services Inc.).

EXCLUSIONS

Items not listed in the summaries are excluded from this proposal.

CHANGES TO SCOPE

If additional work is required or requested, a Change Order will be issued. Change Orders must be signed, approved and the deposit paid prior to commencement of any such work.

MATERIAL PRICING & PROCUREMENT

A summary of materials and their quantities is provided. If material selections are pending, an average allowance is used.

Material allowances are listed to the right of each picture in the Materials Summary, these figures are variable. If final product selection is less than the allowance a credit will be issued for this item, if selection is more than the allowance a change order will be issued for the difference.

The pictures in the Material Summary DO NOT always represent the exact product that will be installed. They are a visual representation to help aid in navigating the Materials Summary.

Material waste is calculated at an average of 10%. Complex installations may require a larger waste percentage.

INCLUSIONS & CROSS-REFERENCES

Some materials required to complete the scope of work may not listed on the materials summary, these are non-substitutable. Substitutable materials will be listed on the materials summary.



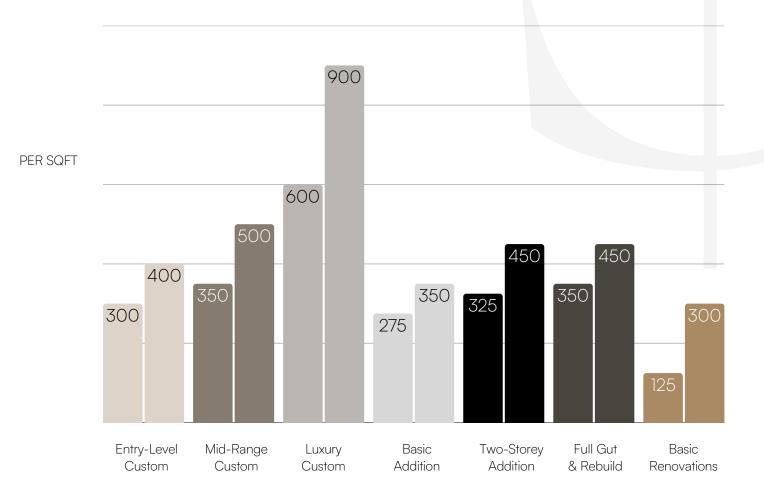

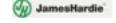

PAYMENT

Your payment schedule is designed to align with the key aspects of your project, ensuring a smooth flow of work and resources. Below is an outline of the payment process. These may vary depending on project scope.

DEPOSIT

35% payment due upon completion of the stage.

DEMOLITION COMPLETE

15% payment due upon completion of the stage.

REBUILD COMPLETE

15% payment due upon completion of the stage.

INFASTRUCTURE COMPLETE

15% payment due upon completion of the stage.

FIT-OUT COMPLETE

15% payment due upon completion of the stage.

FINAL PAYMENT

5% payment due upon completion of the stage.

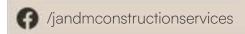
